# Homelessness Intervention Program

Interfaith Partnership's **Homelessness Intervention Program (H.I.P)** is a newly added element aimed at helping individuals who are experiencing homelessness. This program assists single adults who are homeless (currently in a shelter, on the street, in a motel or temporarily staying with family or friends or facing eviction). Individuals in this program receive assistance from case managers in finding safe, affordable housing. After locating housing, case managers continue to provide support services for up to one year in order to assist with housing retention.



## Homelessness Intervention Program Services include:

- Assistance with finding and securing affordable housing
- Assistance with obtaining benefits and subsidies
- Eviction prevention services\Landlord mediation\Case management
- Access to the furniture program
- Advocacy
- Crisis Intervention\Assistance with budgeting\Referrals for other services
